


# Who was Pyotr Tchaikovsky?



Tchaikovsky was a Russian musician and composer. A composer is someone who writes music.

He wrote music for operas and symphonies. A symphony is a long piece of music that is played by an orchestra.

He is also famous for writing music for ballets including 'The Sleeping Beauty', 'Swan Lake' and 'The Nutcracker'.

He was the first Russian composer to be famous outside of his home country.

# What was his life like?

Tchaikovsky grew up in Russia and had a big family. He had four brothers and two sisters.

He started playing the piano at the age of five and

could play as well as his teacher in just

three years!

Tchaikovsky was sent away to boarding school at the age of ten so he could get a job working for the government.

He continued to enjoy playing music. When he was 14, his mother died. He composed a piece of music and dedicated it to her.





After school, Tchaikovsky got a job working for the government. When a new music school opened, in a Russian city called St Petersburg, he gave up his job in order to study music.

After Tchaikovsky finished his own studies, he began to teach music to other students. He continued to compose his own music, which became very popular.



# What was his life like?

Even though Tchaikovsky knew that he loved men instead of women, he got married to a lady called Antonina Miliukova in 1877. At the time, it was against the law for a man to have a romantic relationship with another man. Tchaikovsky hoped that getting married to a woman might make him happy but it didn't. Their marriage was very unhappy and only lasted a few months.

Tchaikovsky became a very famous composer. The ruler of Russia came to some of his concerts and Tchaikovsky was invited to visit the USA and various European countries.

He died in 1893 when he was 53 years old.



### 'The Nutcracker'


Alongside 'Swan Lake', 'The Nutcracker' is one of Tchaikovsky's most famous works.

It is a ballet and was first performed in 1892.


The story is set on Christmas Eve, which makes it a popular ballet around Christmastime.


He and a heartbroken Clara go to bed.


## The Story
